

NOTICE OF REPLY COMMENT PERIOD ON EITE COST RECOVERY BY MINNESOTA POWER

Issued: June 22, 2017

In the Matter of a Revised Petition by Minnesota Power (MP) for a Competitive Rate for Energy-Intensive Trade-Exposed (EITE) Customers and an EITE Cost Recovery Rider

PUC Docket Number: E-015/M-16-564

Comment Period: *Reply comment period closes Wednesday, July 12, 2017 at 4:30 pm*

Docket Background: On June 30, 2016, MP filed a petition with the Commission for approval of a Rider for Energy-Intensive, Trade-Exposed (EITE) customers. On December 21, 2016, the Commission approved MP's rate schedule and corresponding rates for EITE customers. On April 20, 2017, the Commission approved a mechanism allowing MP to recover its cost of providing a rate discount to the EITE customers. Additionally, the Commission ordered MP to submit a compliance filing setting forth the surcharge and refund mechanisms in detail. On May 22, 2017, MP submitted its compliance filing and on June 21, 2017, the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) filed comments.

Topics Open for Comment at this Time: The Commission seeks reply comments regarding MP's compliance filing and OAG's comments.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
