

NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD

In the Matter of Minnesota Power's Petition for Approval of its Electric Vehicle Commercial Charging Rate Pilot

Comment Period: Initial comment period closes June 17, 2019 at 4:30pm

Utility Reply comment period closes June 27, 2019 at 4:30pm

Party Reply comment period closes July 8, 2019 at 4:30pm

Comments received after the close of the comment period may or may not be considered by the Commission.

The Commission has modified its standard comment period format to better facilitate utility and stakeholder input. **June 17** is the initial comment deadline for all interested parties. **June 27** is the deadline for Minnesota Power to respond to party initial comments. **July 8** is the reply comment deadline for all other interested parties. In reply comments, parties should address both initial comments from other parties and Minnesota Power's reply.

The intent of the modified structure is to give Minnesota Power a chance to respond to any stakeholder proposed modifications, and furthermore give stakeholders an opportunity to respond to any modifications proposed in Minnesota Power's reply along with other party comments.

Topic(s) Open for Comment:

- Should the Commission approve Minnesota Power's proposed Electric Vehicle Commercial Charging Rate Pilot?
- Are there other issues or concerns related to this matter?

Background: On May 16, Minnesota Power filed an Electric Vehicle Commercial Charging Rate Pilot for approval. The pilot features a mechanism to limit the portion of a customer's bill that is allocated to the demand charge, and removes the demand charge for usage that occurs in off-peak hours.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties,

participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
