**Annual Compliance Filing Comments**

The Commission has opened an inquiry into Electric Vehicle Charging and Infrastructure in Docket 17-879. To the extent that parties wish to address content from Minnesota Power’s, Otter Tail Power’s, and Xcel Energy’s June 1 annual compliance filings, they should do so in their comments in that Docket. Topics for that comment period can be found in the [May 9, 2018 Notice](#) in Docket E999/PR-17-879.

**Background:** Minn. Stat. §216B.1614 requires the state’s investor-owned utilities to offer a tariff allowing a customer to purchase electricity solely for the purpose of charging an EV. In the spring of 2015, Minnesota Power (in Docket 15-120), Otter Tail Power (in Docket 15-112), and Xcel Energy (in Docket 15-111) each filed an EV tariff. On June 22, 2015, the Commission issued an Order approving the tariffs and requiring annual compliance filings on participation.

On June 1, 2018, Minnesota Power filed its third annual report and also requested tariff modifications to move from an off-peak only tariff to an on/off peak rate design that eliminates control equipment that was not functioning adequately.

**Filing Requirements:** Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: [mn.gov/puc](http://mn.gov/puc), select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
