In the Matter of Minnesota Power's Revised Petition for a Competitive Rate for Energy-Intensive Trade-Exposed (EITE) Customers and an EITE Cost Recovery Rider

Issue: Should the Commission accept Minnesota Power's (MP) second annual EITE compliance filing?

Topic(s) Open for Comment:

- Are there any issues or concerns related to the compliance filing?

Background: In approving both a rate discount for MP's Energy-Intensive Trade-Exposed customers, and a cost recovery (surcharge) mechanism, the Commission required MP to file annually a report detailing the status of the EITE tracker account as well as a number of other issues (see the Commission's orders of December 21, 2016, and April 20, 2017). MP submitted its second annual report on February 1, 2019.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
