Background: On November 8, 2017, Xcel Energy filed its petition for approval of its 2017-2018 Transmission Cost Recovery Rider revenue requirements, in this docket.

On April 2, 2018, the Department submitted *Comments* in which it requested Xcel Energy provide additional information in *Reply Comments*, and in which it stated that the Department would provide "a final set of recommendations" in subsequent response comments.

The Commission also received comments from the Minnesota Office of the Attorney General, Residential Utilities and Antitrust Division.

On May 14, 2018, May 25, 2018, and July 16, 2018, Xcel Energy submitted its *Reply Comments*, and *Supplement to Reply Comments*.
