1. Should the Commission accept Minnesota Power's, Otter Tail Power's, and Xcel Energy's 2018 Safety, Reliability, and Service Quality Metrics reports?
2. Should the Commission approve Minnesota Power's, Otter Tail Power's, and Xcel Energy's proposed reliability standards for 2019?
3. Are there other matters the Commission should consider when reviewing these reports and establishing standards and reporting for 2020?

Parties filing written comments should file individual sets of comments in each respective docket.

Background: Minnesota Power, Otter Tail Power, and Xcel Energy submit annual Safety, Reliability, and Service Quality (SQR) Reports. Standards and reporting requirements are set under Minn. Rules, Chapter 7826 and in Commission orders.

Filing requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are required to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
