Topic(s) Open for Comment:

- Should the Commission amend its August 18, 2017 Order Clarifying Neutral Footprint Objectives and Requiring Compliance Filing to modify the compliance filing system?
- Are there other issues or concerns related to this matter?

Background: On November 7, 2014, the Commission issued an Order Granting a Certificate of Need for the Line 67 Station Upgrade Project – Phase 2 in Marshall, Clearwater, Itasca, Kittson, Red Lake, Cass, and St. Louis Counties. On August 18, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Clarifying Neutral Footprint Objectives and Requiring Compliance Filing.

On October 1, 2019, Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (Enbridge) filed a Neutral Footprint Program Compliance Filing. In this filing, Enbridge proposed a revised reporting system that would modify the filing schedule and combine the filings for the Neutral Footprint Program.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission’s electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
