Topic/s Open for Comment:

- Should the Commission grant the petition of Wisconsin Power and Light to amend the Commission's August 24, 2016 Order to exclude the required monitoring at the Regehr property?

Project Background: On August 24, 2016 the Commission issued an Order requiring Wisconsin Power and Light Company (WPL) to conduct noise monitoring at four residences near the Bent Tree Wind Project. The monitoring was required in order to ascertain compliance with state noise standards due to on-going complaints by the residents at the four properties and due to questions related to WPL's previous noise monitoring. The Order also required that Wisconsin Power and Light meet with the complainants to work to resolve the issues. On February 10, 2017, Wisconsin Power and Light Company filed a motion to amend to exclude the monitoring and meeting requirements for the Regehr property as WPL had documentation that the family had sold the property.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling).
