In the Matter of Xcel Energy's Petition for Approval of a Residential EV Subscription Service Pilot Program

Issue: Should the Commission approve Xcel's Energy Residential EV Subscription Service Pilot?

Topic(s) Open for Comment:

1. Xcel's proposal for implementing a Residential EV Subscription Service Pilot;
 - a. What is the goal of the pilot?
 - b. How does the pilot meet those goals?
 - c. How will Xcel measure and evaluate whether the pilot met those goals?
2. Xcel's proposed Residential EV Subscription Service Pilot customer agreement and tariff;
3. Xcel's accounting treatment and cost recovery proposals for the pilot; and
4. Xcel's proposed request for a rule variance and tariff waiver to implement the Residential EV Subscription Service Pilot.
5. Are there other issues or concerns related to this matter?

Background: On February 22, 2019 Xcel Energy filed for approval of a residential EV subscription pilot program. The proposed program would be similar to Xcel's Residential EV Service pilot (approved by the Commission in Docket No. E002/M-17-817) but customers would be assessed a flat fee for off-peak charging each month instead of a variable energy charge. Customers choosing to charge during the on-peak period would be assessed an on-peak kWh rate after a limited amount of on-peak allowances.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties,

participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
