

NOTICE OF RECONSIDERATION AND COMMENT PERIOD

Please take note that on January 14, 2019 Flying Cow Wind, LLC (Flying Cow or Applicant) submitted a Request for Reconsideration and Rehearing of the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) January 3, 2019 *Order Deferring Action and Initiating Negotiations; Notice and Order for Rehearing*.

Flying Cow has filed a petition for reconsideration of the Commission order under Minn. Rules, 7829.3000, subpart 1. As per Minn. Rules, 7829.3000, subpart 4 other parties to the proceeding shall file answers to a petition for rehearing, amendment, vacation, reconsideration, or re-argument within ten days of service of the petition. After the answers have been received, the petition will be brought to a future agenda meeting.

The deadline for filing answers to this petition for rehearing is January 24, 2019 at 4:30pm. *Answers received after the close of the comment period may or may not be considered by the Commission.*

Background: Under Minn. Stat. §216B.27, subdivision 1, petitions for rehearing are due within 20 days of service of a Commission order. Under Minn. R. 7829.3000, parties are to file answers to a petition for rehearing, amendment, vacation, reconsideration, or re-argument within ten days.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
