In the Matter of Xcel Energy's Petition for Approval of Electric Vehicle Pilot Programs

Topic Open for Comment:

1. Did Xcel comply with Minn. Rules 7829.0420 subpart 2 in making its April 1, 2019 filing?
Are there additional concerns with Xcel's April 1, 2019 filing?
2. Responses to XLI's Petition for Reconsideration and Motion

Please Note: Pursuant to Minn. Rules 7829.1250, the deadline for all replies relating to any petitions for reconsideration, petitions for rehearing, and motions are set at a common date of August 21, 2019

Minnesota Rule 7829.3000 provides timelines for responding to petitions for rehearing or reconsideration. Minnesota Rule 7829.1275 permits the Commission to vary time periods on its own motion for good cause, and to delegate that authority to the executive secretary. The executive secretary has determined that there is good cause to vary the time periods in Minnesota Rule 7829.3000, and establishes the timelines above.

Background: On July 17, 2019, the Commission issued its Order approving Xcel Energy's Fleet and Public Charging Electric Vehicle (EV) pilot programs.

On August 2, 2019, the Department of Commerce requested a Commission rehearing, suspension of the Order, and an additional opportunity for parties to provide comment on Xcel's April 1, 2019 filing in the current docket.

On August 6, 2019, the Xcel Large Industrials (XLI) filed a petition for reconsideration of the Commission's July 17, 2019 order, stating it was "unlawful, not in the public interest, or sufficiently protective of ratepayers, and undermines the Commission's existing policies." XLI also moved for an immediate stay of the Pilot Programs and of the Commission's Order until "the ultimate conclusion of the issues outline in this Petition, including any related appeal."

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
