Dear Commissioner Kelley and Chair Sieben:

Lyon-Lincoln Electric Cooperative, a member-owned electric cooperative, is submitting this letter in response to your March 24, 2020 memorandum regarding utility measures in response to the Covid-19 emergency.

Regarding the three commitments requested in your letter, Lyon-Lincoln Electric Cooperative intends to do all that we can to continue providing uninterrupted electric service to our member-owners during this emergency.

Specifically, Lyon-Lincoln Electric Cooperative intends to delay disconnection of residential services for non-payment of utility bills during the duration of the state peacetime order. The cooperative will waive late fees for the current billing cycle related to the current peacetime emergency order. Finally, the cooperative will arrange payment plans for members requesting help during this emergency order.
