Background: In a series of proceedings, the Commission established a biennial Renewable Energy Standard (RES) compliance process to fulfill its obligations under Minn. Stat. §216B.1691, subd. 7 to "regularly" investigate whether an electric utility is in compliance while coordinating with the Department of Commerce's biennial report to the legislature on the same issues.

The most recent biennial process occurred in Docket E999/M-16-83. As in prior biennial RES compliance dockets, the Commission intends to make formal findings on utilities' compliance with the RES.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
