In the Matter of the Application of the Minnesota Pipeline Company, LLC for a Pipeline Routing Permit for a Crude Oil Pipeline and Associated Aboveground Facilities

Project Background: The Minnesota Public Utilities Commission issued Minnesota Pipeline Company, LLC (MPL) a route permit to construct approximately 303 miles of 24-inch diameter pipeline. Pursuant to Minn. Rule [7852.3900](#), permittees shall file with the Commission written certification that pipeline construction has been completed in compliance with all permit conditions. MPL stated that the installation of the pipeline was completed in late 2008, disturbed areas have been restored and monitoring of the pipeline has been completed in compliance with all permits. In addition, no complaints have been filed in the past three years.

If the Commission accepts the certification, the Commission's jurisdiction over the pipeline routing permit will be terminated.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
