

NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD ON COMPLIANCE REVIEW

In the Matter of the Site Permit of the Trimont Wind I Project in Martin and Jackson Counties

PUC Docket Number(s): IP6907/WS-13-258

Comment Period: Initial comment period closes January 4, 2019 at 4:30pm

It is requested that Trimont Wind I, LLC (Trimont Wind) file a response and/or supplemental information in the initial comment period and the Department of Commerce Energy Environmental Review and Analysis (DOC EERA) staff file responsive comments in the reply period. Comments received after the close of the comment period may or may not be considered by the Commission.

Topic(s) Open for Comment:

- Whether the Trimont Wind compliance filing, dated August 10, 2018 met the obligations of the Commission's June 14, 2018 Order
- Action the Commission should take following the comments of the DOC EERA Compliance Review dated December 7, 2018
- Any other issues or concerns related to this matter

Background: On June 14, 2018 the Commission released its *Order Issuing Amended Site Permit and Requiring Monitoring* regarding the Trimont Wind I Repowering Project (Trimont) proposal submitted in December 2017. As part of that approval, and in response to several issues that arose during the review process, the Commission in its order required Trimont to file a compliance filing related to the MPCA noise standard, required noise monitoring, and other items. On August 10, 2018, Trimont filed a response to the Commission's Order Point 2 regarding compliance with permit conditions relating to noise and the MPCA noise standard. The DOC EERA filed a review on December 7, 2018 that indicated it did not believe Trimont's filing met the obligation under the Commission's Order.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
