This notice applies to all four impacted natural gas utilities.¹

If any information requested in this notice is duplicative or has already been provided, please identify where in the record of these dockets that information is located.

Comments received after the close of the comment period may or may not be considered by the Commission.

Issues:

- Were the extraordinary February 2021 gas costs incurred individually by CenterPoint,² Xcel,³ MERC,⁴ and Great Plains⁵ (collectively “the companies” or the “impacted natural gas utilities”) prudent?
- Should any extraordinary February 2021 gas costs be disallowed?
- How should extraordinary February 2021 gas costs be defined?
- What dates should extraordinary February 2021 gas costs encompass?
- When should the recovery period begin and how long should it last?
- Should recovery be via a volumetric or a fixed charge?
- Should carrying costs, if requested, be approved?
- Are any rule variances needed to implement recovery?

Topics Open for Comment:

- Should the Commission authorize one or more of the companies to establish a regulatory asset account to track the February Market Event gas costs paid to suppliers, the costs to finance the gas costs incurred, payments collected from customers, and any offsets to the recoverable costs?
- Should the Commission approve recovery of the February Market Event gas costs through a separate surcharge or through the existing AAA true-up mechanism?
- If a separate surcharge is used, should the February Market Event costs be recovered through a fixed or volumetric surcharge and should this surcharge have variable summer and winter rates?⁶ How does this compare to what each company has indicated is their preferred method for recovering these costs?

⁶ For each Company, please provide a comparison of the standard cost recovery volumetric rate (for 12 mos.) to:

-18 mos. – volumetric rate

-24 mos. – volumetric rate

-24 mos. – volumetric rate that doubles in the second year

-24 mos. – volumetric rates that are lower during the heating season and higher in the non-heating season and double in the second year.

-24 mos. – fixed charge (no variation in fixed charge between the heating season and non-heating season or the first year and the second year)

-24 mos. – fixed charge rate doubles in second year

- If a separate surcharge is used, when should recovery of the February Market Event gas costs begin and over what period should recovery be extended?
- Should any of the impacted natural gas utilities be allowed to recover financing costs associated with the February Market Event costs?
- Should any of the companies be authorized to establish a regulatory asset to track and defer bad debt expense associated with the February Market Event?
- Did the companies act reasonably and prudently during the February Market Event when purchasing gas on the spot market?
- Did the companies act reasonably and prudently prior to and during the February Market Event to mitigate and avoid costs they now seeks to recover? (Responses to this question should consider, without limitation, each company’s strategy involving hedging, storage, peak shaving, curtailing, conservation planning, and any other mitigation strategies identified in the petitions and/or initial filings submitted in these dockets, including Docket No. 21-135.)
- Are the extraordinary gas costs prudent given that the companies did not curtail or notify and ask residential and other firm customers to conserve their use of gas prior to or during the cold weather event? How should the Commission consider this?
- Are the reported amounts of each company’s additional gas costs during the February Market Event reasonably accurate?
- If a separate surcharge is used, should CenterPoint, Xcel, MERC or Great Plains implement a low-income rate to protect financially vulnerable customers? And, if so, how should the low-income rate be designed?
- Is CenterPoint’s proposal to recover 50 percent of the separate and standard residential customer non-low-income surcharge from Gas Affordability Program (GAP) participants reasonable?
- Does CenterPoint’s proposal to discount the separate surcharge for GAP customers provide sufficient bill impact mitigation for CenterPoint’s non-low-income residential customers?
- Should Xcel, MERC and Great Plains be required to modify the design of their GAPs or how the cost of these programs are recovered?
- Are the proposals to recover costs via a fixed or volumetric surcharge (as adjusted for qualifying low-income customers) reasonable?
- Should costs be phased in over two years with variable summer and winter rates?
- Is it reasonable for any of the companies to recover “financing costs” from ratepayers?
- If so: [a] should the Commission impose any limitations on the amount or nature of financing costs that are recoverable? And [b] what would be a reasonable interest rate?
- How will additional assistance from the State or other sources, if granted, complement cost recovery under each company’s proposal?
- Are any rule variances needed to implement recovery? Please identify the specific rule and explain how and why the rule needs to be varied.

- What dates should extraordinary February 2021 gas costs encompass?
- Are there any other issues or concerns related to this matter?

Background

On February 23, 2021, the Commission held a special planning meeting to hear comments from the rate regulated natural gas utilities, the Minnesota Department of Commerce (Department), Division of Energy Resources, and the Minnesota Office of the Attorney General—Residential Utilities Division (OAG), on the impact of the February 2021 cold weather on the natural gas utilities and their customers.

On March 2, 2021, the Commission issued an ORDER OPENING INVESTIGATION,⁷ and directed the impacted natural gas utilities to file information related to the February 2021 cold weather event.

On March 10, 2021, the Commission issued its REQUEST FOR INITIAL FILINGS AND NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD.⁸ Initial filings were submitted on April 9, 2021, comments on May 10, 2021, and reply comments are due on May 20, 2021.⁹

On March 16, 2021,¹⁰ CenterPoint filed a petition seeking to recover an estimated \$500 million in additional gas costs related to the February 2021 cold weather. The petition seeks Commission approval to recover these costs over a two-year period starting on May 1, 2021 or as soon as possible.

On March 30, 2021, Great Plains submitted its request for variances to Minn. Rule 7825.2910, Subpart 4, and Minn. Rule 7825.2700, Subpart 7, to allow an alternative computation of its annual true-up surcharge and an alternative timing for implementation of this proposed true-up. Great Plains is seeking to recover approximately \$11 million in additional gas costs related to the February 2021 cold weather over a twenty-eight month period starting in May 2021.

On May 13, 2021, the Commission met to consider how to proceed and voted to deny CenterPoint's and Great Plains's requests to begin recovering these extraordinary gas costs in May 2021, not consolidate the requests from CenterPoint and Great Plains into the investigation docket, direct that all comments should be cross-filed in the investigation docket, authorize the Commission's Executive Secretary to issue this notice that applies to all four of the impacted
