In the Matter of a Petition by Otter Tail Power Company for Approval of the Annual Update to its Energy-Intensive Trade-Exposed (EITE) Rider Surcharge Rate

Issue: Should the Commission accept Otter Tail Power Company's (Otter Tail) first annual EITE compliance filing?

Topic(s) Open for Comment:

- Are there any issues or concerns related to the compliance filing?

Background: In approving both a rate discount for Otter Tail's Energy-Intensive Trade-Exposed customers, and a cost recovery (surcharge) mechanism, the Commission required Otter Tail to annually file a report detailing the status of the EITE tracker account as well as a number of other issues (see the Commission's Orders of November 17, 2017, and May 29, 2018 in Docket No. E-017/M-17-257). Otter Tail submitted its first annual report on March 1, 2019.

Filing Requirements: Utilities, telecommunications carriers, official parties, and state agencies are **required** to file documents using the Commission's electronic filing system (eFiling). All parties, participants and interested persons are encouraged to use eFiling: mn.gov/puc, select *eFiling*, and follow the prompts.
