

**NOTICE OF COMMENT ON  
APPLICATION TO AMEND LINE 3 PIPELINE ROUTING PERMIT**

Issued: May 10, 2019

**In the Matter of the Application of Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership for a Route Permit for the Line 3 Replacement Project in Minnesota from the North Dakota Border to the Wisconsin Border**

**PUC Docket Number:** PL9/PPL-15-137

**Topics for Comment:**

- Should the Commission approve the route width and centerline modifications requested by Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership in its May 3, 2019 filing?
- Do any of the proposed route width and centerline modifications create new or additional human or environmental impacts to the permitted route?

**Background:** On May 3, 2019, Enbridge Energy, Limited Partnership (Enbridge) filed an application requesting approval of 17 route width and centerline modifications to the Line 3 Replacement Project permitted route. The Line 3 Replacement Project is a new 330-mile long 36-inch diameter pipeline that replaces 282 miles of the existing 34-inch Line 3 pipeline in Minnesota. The pipeline route crosses portions of Kittson, Marshall, Pennington, Red Lake, Polk, Clearwater, Hubbard, Wadena, Cass, Crow Wing, Aitkin, St. Louis, and Carlton counties. The Commission granted a routing permit for the Line 3 Replacement Project on October 26, 2018. Certain conditions in the routing permit were amended on January 18, 2019.
